### **Living with FASD**

#### WHAT KIND OF ASSESSMENT SHOULD YOU GET?

FASD is BRAIN and CNS (central nervous system) impact/damage that is lifelong and permanent

<u>Neuropsychologists</u> are highly trained professionals specializing in the study of brain and behaviour relations using techniques that <u>go beyond</u> the standard psychological evaluations.

Neuropsychologists are able to make inferences about presence or absence of brain dysfunction, including strengths and weaknesses, which assist in the treatment selection and planning, employability status and modifications needed for learning or daily living environment.

A <u>neuropsychological assessment is the most "accurate and valid" means</u> to determine the extent of cognitive (mental comprehension) impairment and the detection of neuropsychiatric disorders and dysfunctions Would you let your lawyer, even the best, operate on your brain?

Standard psychological and psycho-educational <u>evaluations</u> using standardized test batteries, <u>while useful</u>, are not sensitive to the effects of brain damage and are not designed to identify systemic change in a person's neurocognitive functioning over time and do not go beyond a simple determination of I.Q or academic level.

Neuropsychological Assessment is complemented by a Neurological (medical) evaluations but offers more detailed information about higher cognitive functioning
